



#### The Paris Agreement called for countries to produce "mid-century, long-term low greenhouse gas emission development strategies"





# Understanding long-term goals and options can inform near-term plans



#### **Key Questions**

- How can countries and stakeholders effectively <u>develop momentum</u>, <u>buy-in, and support</u> for LTS that can, in turn, support near term action?
- How can long-term <u>sectoral pathways and strategies</u>, including technology innovation, be effectively developed and catalyze near term actions?
- How can LTS and NDC processes and implementation be <u>linked in</u> <u>practice</u>?
- How can key higher level elements be integrated and operationalized within LTS (including <u>SDGs, resilience/adaptation, and finance</u>)?
- What types of <u>analytical methods</u> (e.g., scenarios and models) are available to support LTS to enable near term action, and what considerations should be taken in choosing and pursuing key analysis?
