What is HEAT+?

ICLEI's multilingual online emissions inventory tool to help Local Governments to account Greenhouse Gas Emissions (GHGs), Common Air Pollutants (CAP) and other Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC)

On one single platform, HEAT+ enables cities and towns to:

- Prepare a baseline inventory
- Forecast emissions, e.g. Business-as-Usual (BAU) scenario
- Determine priorities
- Prepare action plans
- Track commitments
- Measure and quantify progress against targets through monitoring inventories
- Inform policy decisions
- Report "scope" differentiated results
- Report to the international reporting platform for cities: CDP- ICLEI Track and thereby to the Global Covenant of Mayors for Climate & Energy (GCoM)

Why HEAT+?

HEAT+ helps Local Governments to make informed climate action decisions and identify the most effective measures for GHG emissions abatement

- Consistent with Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) guidelines
- Compliant with the new Global Protocol on Community-Scale Greenhouse Gas Emissions (GPC), the
 global framework that harmonizes GHG emissions measurement and reporting processes for cities of
 all sizes worldwide
- 12 Country versions are available in multi-language
- Online access is available to users 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
