Growing Momentum for “Aligned” NDCs

- Growing political consensus for aligning NDCs with net-zero emissions, LT-LEDS, and 1.5°C
- 2015: PA sets temperature goal, introduces net-zero, mandates NDCs, and encourages LT-LEDS
- 2021: GCP reaffirms 1.5°C, describes 2030 and mid-century benchmarks, notes importance of NDC & LT-LEDS alignment, “towards just transitions to net zero”
- 2023: First GST encouraged NDC alignment with 1.5°C, strengthened reduction targets, describes 2035 emissions benchmark



State of Play of LT-LEDS

LT LEDS STATE OF PLAY

- In accordance with the Paris Agreement, all Parties should strive to formulate and communicate long-term low greenhouse gas emission development strategies.
- The CMA5 decision urges Parties that have not yet done so and invites all other Parties to communicate or revise, by November 2024. It notes the importance of aligning NDCs with LT-LDES.

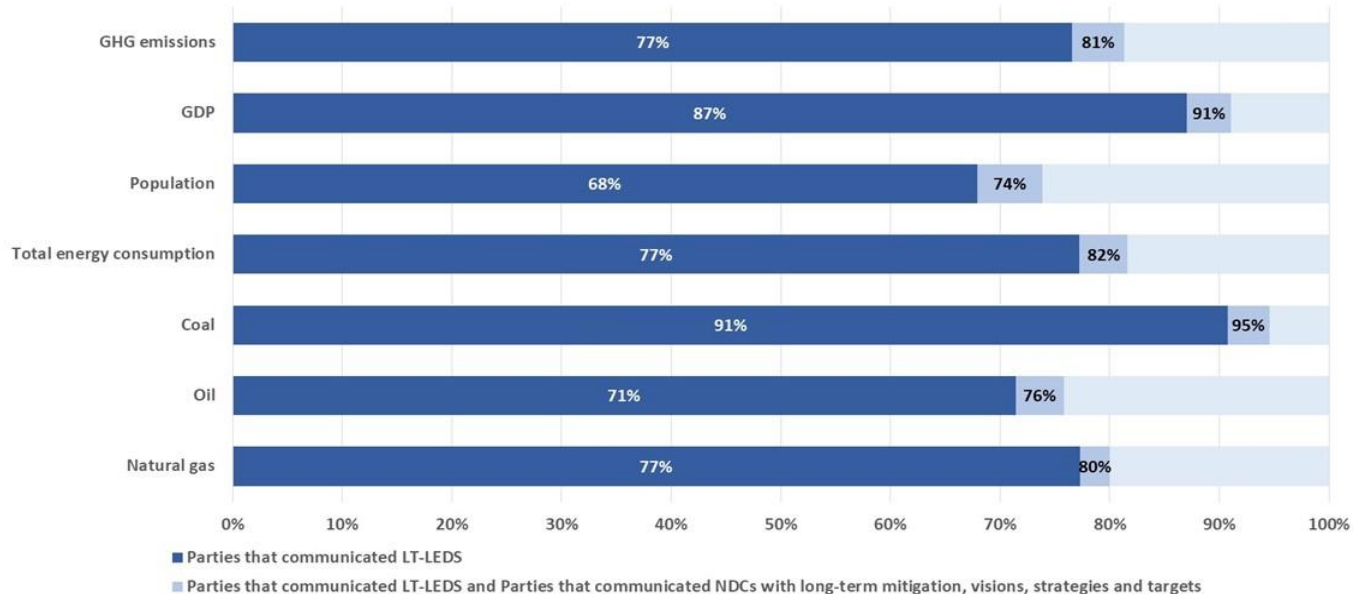
UNFCCC LT-LEDS SYNTHESIS REPORT

- The report synthesizes information from the 68 latest available LT-LEDS, representing 75 Parties to the Paris Agreement (as for September 2023).

Global share of Parties submitted LT-LEDS

The LT-LEDS synthesis report 2023 was prepared in response to the request from CMA.3

- The report synthesized information from the 68 latest available LT-LEDS including 7 update, recorded on UNFCCC website as at 25 September 2023.
- Since then, 5 LT-LEDS including 3 update were submitted (as at 23 July 2024).



Key findings: Low-emission climate resilient development

All LT-LEDS provided a development perspective

(development visions, priorities and principles or economic, social and environment objectives)

- **81% LT-LEDS contained information on just transition and related elements** including 57% LT-LEDS directly referred to just transition.
(e.g. job creation, investment for economic transformation, training and education)
- **65% LT-LEDS provided information on macroeconomic effect** including 43% LT-LEDS mentioned quantitative impact on GDP and 37% quantitative impact on employment.
- **97% LT-LEDS included adaptation-related information** including 79% LT-LEDS described climate change hazards, risks, vulnerability and impacts on priority sectors, 82% policies and frameworks, 78% synergies with mitigation, 34% on quantified targets.
- **Net-zero included in majority of LT-LEDS (around 62%)**
- **71% of LT-LEDS referred to linkages with the SDGs**

Unpacking NDC Alignment

Unpacking Alignment with Net-Zero and Long-term Targets

Considerations for LT-LEDS alignment:

- Development priorities and pathways
- Macroeconomic considerations
- Financing and support needs
- Adaptation
- Just transitions

NDC alignment claims should include:

1. Transparent near-term and net-zero/long-term targets, following established guidance
2. An economy-wide emissions trajectory through the long-term target year & assumptions about what happens after the target year through 2100
3. Emissions targets for 2030 and 2035 based on the emissions trajectory
4. Underlying technology, policy, and financial plans (and related sectoral targets) that support the emissions pathway
5. Explanation of pathway alignment with fair share and how the country is addressing any conflict between its fair share and other critical considerations

Final Considerations

- **Speed is key:** Near-term action is crucial as temperature rise is driven by cumulative emissions.
- **Context matters:** A nuanced, holistic, and multidimensional view of alignment can go beyond binary categorization of NDCs as "aligned" or "not aligned".
- **Seize the moment:** Countries could standardize alignment information as part of pre-COP29 NDC clarity and transparency work and could further discuss it at COP.

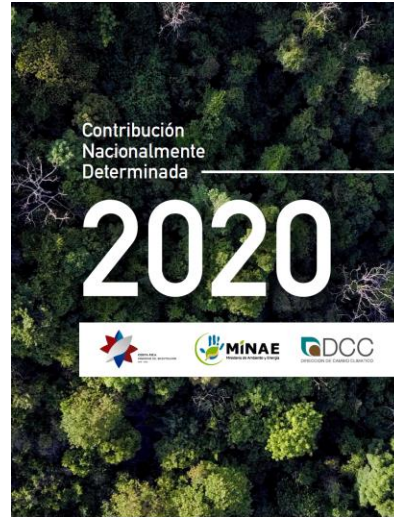

The Global Call gives countries access to expertise and dedicated resources to align, update, and enhance NDCs and LT-LEDS in line with the Paris Agreement.

By engaging in the Global Call countries can leverage Partnership support to:

- Assess needs, plan and develop NDCs 3.0 & LT-LEDS,
- Align NDCs 3.0 and LT-LEDS,
- Catalyze the implementation of transformative policies,
- Mobilize technical assistance that matches country needs, and
- Access on demand specialists, including from 2050 Pathways Platform.

The NDC 3.0 Navigator is an interactive tool that supports the development of NDCs to be submitted in 2025. It helps countries:

- Raise ambition and accelerate implementation of the next round of NDCs,
- Provides guidance for aligning NDCs with LT-LEDS, as well as with key policy documents such as NAPs and National Development Plans, and
- Offers context-specific insights for countries to deliver a just and equitable transition.
